



# Aspiring Administrator Network

Program Purpose: To give aspiring school leaders all the tools needed to become an effective and high-performing assistant principal.

The Aspiring Administrator Network (AAN) is a year-long professional development opportunity, with a possible individualized second year follow-up plan, designed to prepare those who aspire to attain an administration position. The learning is designed with a focus on developing and enhancing leadership skills and to broaden knowledge of administrator expectations. An assistant principal panel discussion and mock interviews are also part of the network. Eligibility requirements include a desire to be a campus administrator; master's degree with administrator certification; a minimum of 3 years' experience as a teacher; recommendation by the campus principal; and a video interview by the CISD Leadership Committee.
